

# **OOTK 21ST CENTURY – 2ND OPERATION & 3<sup>rd</sup> OPERATION– THE HOUSES & THE ZODIAC**

## **2<sup>nd</sup> OPERATION – THE HOUSES**

Shuffle the deck. Cut the deck into 12 Piles by dealing the cards out as follows;

1	2	3	4	5	6
12	11	10	9	8	7

13<sup>th</sup> card would go in Pile 1 and the 14th in Pile 2 and so on until the whole deck is dealt into these 12 piles.

These piles represent the 12 Houses of the Zodiac. Once you've dealt the deck into these 12 piles, flip the packs over and consider the top cards as they pertain to the house they are in. Then **WITHOUT DISTURBING THE ORDER OF THE CARDS** go through each pile until you've located the Significator. The pile containing the significator is the Pile that you will read. Consider how the question is affected by the nature of the House in which the Significator appears to further develop the answer and add to the story..

Count and pair the cards as before.

## **3<sup>rd</sup> OPERATION – THE ZODIAC**

Shuffle the cards and cut into 12 Piles as you did in the Houses Operation only this time the 12 packs represent the signs of the Zodiac (signs are in order starting with the Aries and ending with Pisces).

The time period and the general meaning of the sign of the Zodiac in which the significator appears is important in relation to the answer of the question.

If the sign of the pack is in the same time period as when the reading is done then the information you uncover during counting and pairing relates to the present. If it is not more than 3 months prior to the reading, then it relates to the past, otherwise it relates to the future.

Count and pair as before.
